Guests, Membership, & New Club Sponsorship:

- 5 – Points for each guest who attends a Green River Kiwanis weekly meeting (a guest may only be counted for points one time, regardless of how many times they come).
- 35 – Points / New Member
- 50 – Points for sponsoring a new Circle K, Key Club or Kiwanis Club

Committees or Club Positions:

5 – Points for each Co Chair	10 – Points for each member of the Audit Committee
10 – Points for each Committee Chair	10 – Points for BUG School Leader / Chair
15 – Points for the BUG Chair / Coordinator	25 – Points for Club Directory Coordinator
25 – Points for the Facebook Czar	25 – Points for the Web Czar

Poinsettias:

- 1 – Point for every 4 Poinsettia Plants sold
- 2 – Points for unloading Plants
- 2 – Points per hour for poinsettia delivery
- 15 – Points for the Czar Assistant(s)
- 25 – Points for the Poinsettia Czar
- 25 – BONUS Points will be awarded to each team with 100% participation based on 4 plants sold or cash equivalent donated to the club.

Dream Center Rib & Tenderloin Sale:

- 1 – Point for every rack of Ribs or 2 Tenderloins sold
- 2 – Points for assistance with Rib & Tenderloin Pick Up
- 5 – Points for attending / preparing a Dream Center Meal or volunteering at another Dream Center event
- 25 – BONUS Points will be awarded to each team with 100% participation based on 2 ribs/4 tenderloins sold or cash equivalent donated to the Club.

Special Events or Circumstances (Note: 'Shifts' for all activities are 2 hours in length unless otherwise noted):

- 1 – Point per ticket purchased for Water for People concert (or equivalent donated to Water for People)
- 2 – Points for volunteering at a charity organization that has provided a speaker in the current Kiwanis year
- 5 – Points for any member who is the program speaker at a regularly scheduled GRK meeting (excl. committee chairs)
- 5 – Points for attendance at any regularly scheduled Kiwanis local Southwind Division meeting
- 5 – Points per person per shift for working Fantasy of Lights
- 5 – Points per person for calling on behalf of Easter Seals
- 5 – Points per person per shift for working at Tri-State Food Bank
- 5 – Points per blood donation during a Kiwanis / Red Cross Blood Drive and / or recruiting a non-Kiwanian to donate during the blood drive
- 5 – Points per shift worked for 4-H County Fair
- 5 – Points for volunteering at a Community One event
- 5 – Points for per shift worked at any Southwind Division club fundraising project

Special Events or Circumstances (continued):

- 5 – Points for per shift worked for Special Olympics Bowling
- 10 – Points for individual(s) / Team who coordinates speakers for a month
- 10 - Points for any member who speaks at any Evansville-area, non-Kiwanis group **AND** GRK membership is mentioned
- 10 – Points for attendance at any “Officially” sponsored Kiwanis Division/State/International event (excl. Division Council)
- 10 – Points for teams who bring doughnuts for the month

Golf Outing:

- 1 – Point for attendance at a Comm. Meeting
- 5 – Points for Committee Members
- 5 – Points Worker
- 10 – Points for Corporate or Title Sponsor**
- 5 – Points Hole sponsor**
- 5 – Points Player**
- 10 – Points for Foursome Sponsor**
- 25 – Points for Committee Chairman

(** - Provided they pay to play/sponsor)

Riley Walk:

- 1 – Point for attendance at a Comm. meeting
- 5 – Points for Committee Members
- 25 – Points for Committee Chairman
- 25 – Points for Committee Technology Czar
- 1 – Point per \$25 donated to Riley Walk (Individuals)
- 10 – Points for attendance at Riley Walk (provided they pay to walk)
- 25 – Points for Committee Treasurer

- 15 – Points for the team with the **third-most** money raised for the Riley Walk
- 25 – Points for the team with the **second-most** money raised for the Riley Walk
- 50 – Points for the team with the **most** money raised for the Riley Walk

Kiwanis for Kids:

- 20 – Points for Transportation for Riley Hospital Patient(s)
- 25 – Points for Teaching JA (per teacher, per course)
- 50 – Points for Mentoring a student (must complete full school grade year for eligibility and be a program endorsed by Kiwanis)

YEAR END TEAM BONUSES:

- 25 – Points for each member who attends 45≥ Green River Kiwanis Club weekly meetings (no make-ups or substitutions allowed)
- 50 – Points for any team with a net gain of 2 members
- 50 – Points for Interclub attendance of **all** of the following Southwind Division Interclubs

- 50 – Points for Interclub attendance of **all** of the following Southwind Division Circle K & Key Clubs

GRK Point Turn In Protocols

*All Points, with the only exceptions being weekly attendance and Poinsettia activity, will be reported by the Team Captain or Co-Captain by the 15th of the following month or they will **NOT** be counted.

*All points must be submitted using the Club Point form (can be found on the website, www.greenriverkiwanis.org)

*Chairpersons or Coordinators in charge of an event such as Rib & Tenderloin Sales, BUG, and Special Olympics, must turn in a participation sheet demonstrating who participated to the Team Captains. Team Captains will then be responsible for submitting the assigned points for their respective team points to the Point Czar.

Any GRK Member may submit a request in writing to any member of the Points Committee (comprised of the Immediate Past President, President, and President Elect) for the assignment of point(s) to an event or activity for the next Kiwanis Year. New point assignments to events or activities **will only be assigned prospectively** for the next Kiwanis Year, **not retrospectively**. The request will be considered at the end-of-the-year September GRK Board Meeting. Merits of the request will be based upon the following guidelines:

- How does the event or activity benefit Green River Kiwanis?
- How does the event or activity benefit our Community?
- How does the event or activity benefit the Children we have pledged to serve?
