This organization covers 11 local counties and serves girls from K-12. She talked about after school activities dealing with healthy habits, making good choices, risk awareness, and growing self-confidence. These are apd—alternative program development—things that don't involve girls being in a scout troop. They are largely grant funded, and attendees are actually registered as Girl Scouts. They are operated by staff members, and are offered in community centers and 21st century schools.
