Local newspapers (Courier, Gleaner, Owensboro and Princeton) are read over the air for those with deficits of a sort that make reading the paper difficult. Some listeners are visually impaired, others may find it difficult to hold the paper, and some are in hospice. There is also a national service that reads news 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. The area news is read 8-12 Monday through Friday and 9-1 on weekends. This is all done by volunteers. WNIN pays for the newspapers and subscriptions to the streaming services. Volunteers are always welcome—you could contact **Todd** for more information, or visit when he reads to see how it all works. 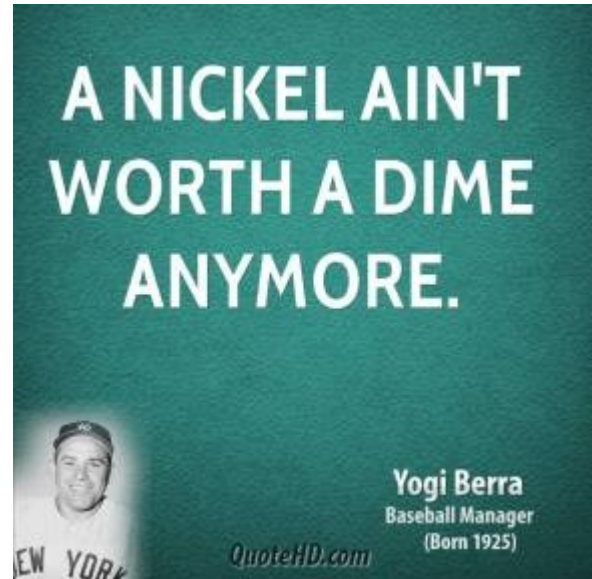

Location of pick-up: All pick-ups will be at Christ Church United Church of Christ, 3601 Washington Ave. (immediately west of the Protestant Home and across the street from the Ronald McDonald House).
